

Collaborating for Sight and Service: Participation in Netra Kumbh

During the spiritually historic Mahakumbh at Prayagraj, Shri Sadguru Seva Sangh Trust participated in the Netra Kumbh initiative—a large-scale, inclusive eye care mission led by Saksham and its partner organisations. The initiative aimed to serve pilgrims and individuals with vision impairment during the sacred congregation.

As part of the Netra Kumbh, the Trust was entrusted with managing one of the screening clusters. A dedicated team of over 25 professionals, including ophthalmologists, optometrists, vision technicians and field coordinators were deployed. The cluster was equipped with advanced diagnostic tools, including slit lamps and fundus imaging systems, enabling high-quality screening and diagnosis on-site.

In addition to our participation in the Netra Kumbh initiative, Shri Sadguru Seva Sangh Trust also independently organised outreach eye care camps in high-footfall areas around the Kumbh Mela, including Nirmohi Akhara, Ranchhoddas Nagar and Ramayani Kuti. These camps extended our mission of restoring sight and dignity to the underserved, far beyond our assigned cluster.





"SWASTH DRISHTI - SAMRIDDH KASHI" FROM VISION TO IMPACT



A Community - Driven Eye Health Movement, Inspired by a National Vision

The Swasth Drishti – Samriddh Kashi Abhiyan was launched by Shri Sadguru Seva Sangh Trust in response to the clarion call of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India to make Varanasi a model for accessible, inclusive and cataract blindness-free eye care.

Deeply inspired by this national vision, the Trust initiated a district-wide campaign focused on eliminating avoidable blindness due to cataract and improving access to quality eye care across the sacred geography of Kashi and its surrounding districts.

Rooted in Sadguru's longstanding ethos of rural service, the initiative was implemented in close coordination with the government health system, including active involvement of ASHAs, Anganwadi workers and local administrative bodies. The campaign featured door-to-door screening of all individuals aged 50 and above, awareness generation activities targeting all age groups and primary eye screening camps conducted in partnership with government health facilities. Surgical referrals were made to Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya, Chitrakoot and nearby government hospitals in Varanasi.

Transforming Vision Across Varanasi: Impact Snapshot

- 7,02,253+ individuals aged 50+ and above screened through door-to-door outreach
- 14,200+ cataract surgeries conducted at Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya, Chitrakoot
- 59,055+ spectacles distributed to restore vision, enhance quality of life and support livelihoods
- Extensive school screenings and sectoral outreach carried out to promote early detection among children and working adults across Varanasi

The Swasth Drishti – Samriddh Kashi Abhiyan has laid the foundation for a transformative new chapter in Sadguru's journey: the establishment of **Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya**, **Kashi**, a state-of-the-art tertiary-level eye hospital in Varanasi. This marks a significant shift from camp-based care to a permanent, advanced and inclusive model of eye health for underserved communities across Varanasi and the wider Purvanchal region. The hospital will provide comprehensive consultations, advanced surgeries, specialised clinics, training and research—supported by a robust network of Sadguru City Eye Clinics and Vision Centers, which serve as tertiary-level advanced eye care hubs for early detection, community screening and seamless referrals.




TRAINING & CAPACITY BUILDING IN EYE HEALTH



Strengthening Eye Health Systems Through Skilled Human Capital

Shri Sadguru Seva Sangh Trust remains committed to advancing eye health delivery by strengthening the skills and leadership capacity of professionals across India and neighbouring regions. Through structured training programs, peer learning platforms and targeted workshops, the Trust has fostered excellence in both clinical and operational domains of eye care.

Our training initiatives cater to a broad spectrum of participants - including ophthalmologists, allied ophthalmic personnel, nurses and eye hospital administrators - representing both government and nongovernment sectors. Emphasizing practical learning, all programs are designed to elevate clinical expertise, improve patient care systems and promote sustainable service delivery models.





SNC, in collaboration with SEVA Foundation and LAICO, Aravind Eye Care System, hosted the Eyexcel Training Programme with participation from 11 leading eye hospitals. The training focused on strengthening institutional training systems in eye care through interactive sessions and collaborative learning. It was facilitated by Mr. Arun Acharya (Global Training Head, SEVA Foundation).



SNC, in collaboration with Cankids and Dr. Shroff's Charity Eye Hospital, organized a Retinoblastoma awareness workshop. The session aimed to improve the early detection of eye conditions. Experts included Dr. Amita Mahajan (Apollo Hospital), Dr. Sima Das (Dr. Shroff Hospital), Dr. Alok Sen and Dr. Narendra Patidar (SNC Chitrakoot).



SNC hosted the workshop to strengthen interstate collaboration for advancing comprehensive eye care. Key representatives from Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Chhattisgarh participated. The event also celebrated 20 years of Vision 2020, highlighting collective efforts to eliminate avoidable blindness in India.



SNC organized a Refresher Training Programme for Government NHM-UP Ophthalmic Assistants under the NPCB & VI. Aimed at empowering 250 eye care professionals, the initiative focuses on enhancing clinical skills, improving service quality and strengthening the public eye care delivery system across Uttar Pradesh.



THE JOURNEY OF RASHI DWIVEDI

A Story of Hope and Independence



Rashi Dwivedi, an 18-year-old girl from a small village in Manikpur, Chitrakoot (U.P.), comes from a lower-middle-class family of seven. She lives with her mother and six sisters. A year ago, her father-the sole breadwinner of the family-was diagnosed with cancer, which led to a severe financial crisis. Despite support from her grandfather, the family couldn't afford the ongoing treatment and sadly, her father passed away. All their savings were exhausted during his treatment.

Currently, Rashi's grandfather is the only source of financial support. He runs a small ice cream shop, but due to mounting financial difficulties and the expenses incurred during his son's illness, the shop is now on the verge of shutting down.

With no stable income, the family considered discontinuing the daughters' education. Rashi resigned herself to household chores, believing her dreams didn't matter-until she learned about the Allied Ophthalmic Personnel (AOP) Training Programme at Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya, supported by SCB & MFV. She enrolled, becoming the first girl in her family to step out for education.

Now undergoing structured training, Rashi is building a secure future.
