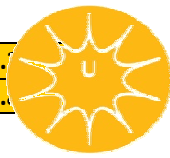

(like Ophthalmologists, OT Supervisor, Optometrists, and OPD Supervisor and Outreach team).

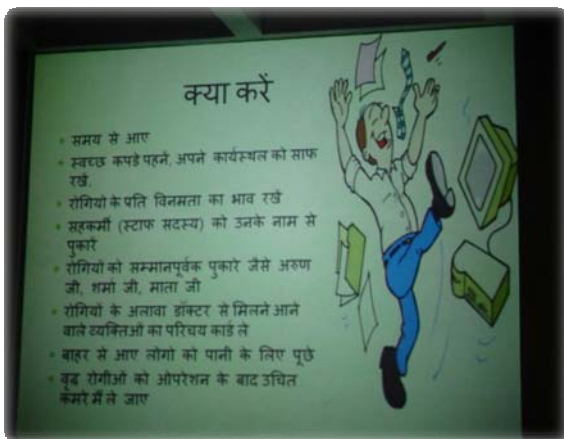
Annual ORBIS India Partner meet
