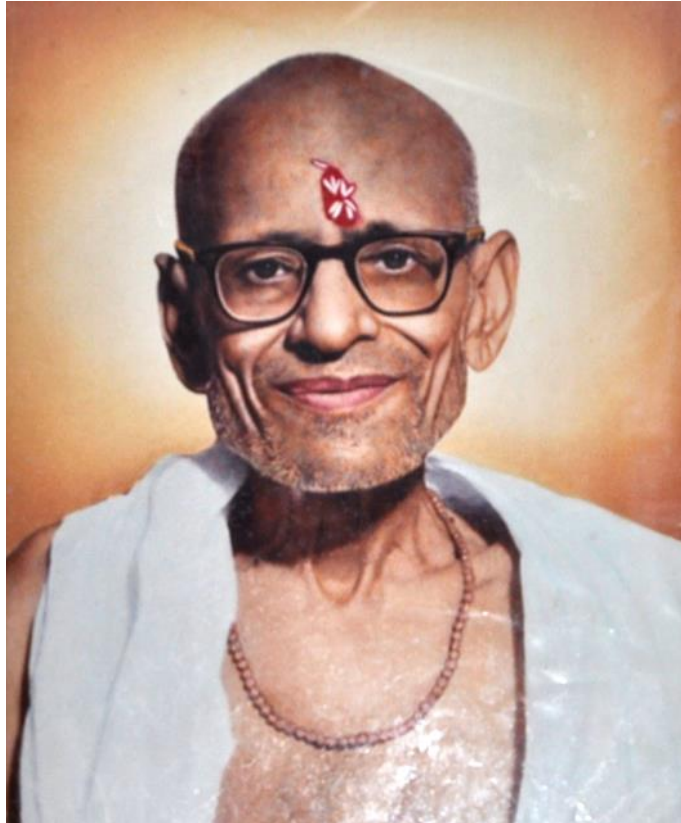

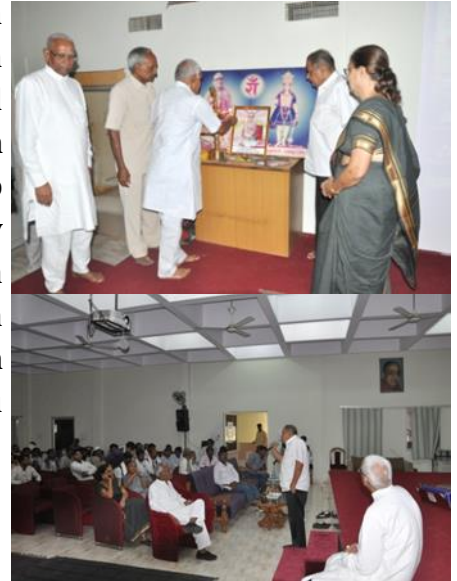


OTHER ACTIVITIES
