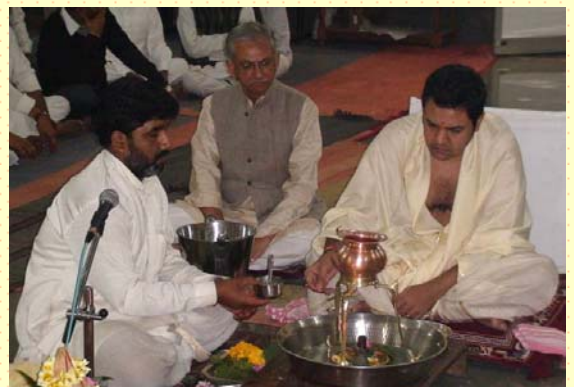


### Ramkatha Evam Ramayan Paath:

## Lectures on Gurudev's life and teachings:



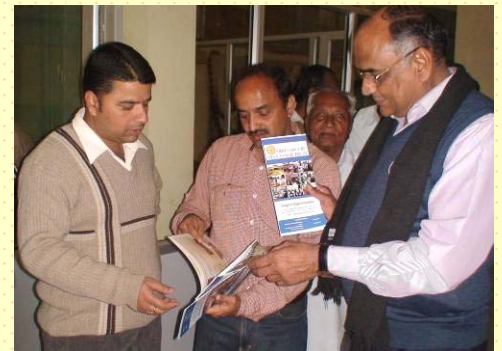
