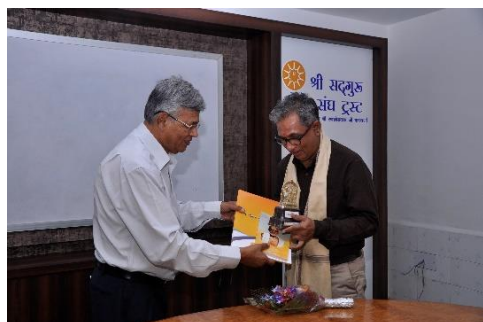


Shri Narendra Singh Tomar, 28th February, 2017
