Workshop on Glaucoma



Glaucoma is the second largest cause of blindness after Cataract. The identification and treatment of glaucoma is very often a complex task and follow up a major issue. Considering the gray zones related to the diagnosis and treatment of glaucoma a one day workshop was organized on 11th July 2010 by Shri Sadguru Sankalp Netra Chikitsalaya at Hotel Lake View Ashok, Bhopal. The workshop was chaired by Dr. (Mrs.) S. Bisaria, Prof. of Ophthalmology, GMC Bhopal. The special guest for the occasion was Dr. Vijay Anand Joshi, Joint Director Health Services, Gov. of M.P.
