## Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya

## Family Planning (Laparoscopic tubectomy) Camp: 21<sup>st</sup> Oct and 18<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2010

Laparoscopic tubectomy surgery in India is considered as the safest method for permanent pregnancy control. ## Inauguration of Laparoscopy machine: 9<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2010

Laparoscopic surgery, also called minimally invasive surgery (MIS), bandaid surgery, keyhole surgery is a modern surgical technique in which operations in the abdomen are performed through small incisions (usually 0.5–1.5 cm) as compared to the larger incisions needed in laparotomy. Keyhole surgery uses images displayed on TV monitors for magnification of the surgical elements. Laparoscopic surgery includes operations within the abdominal or pelvic cavities, whereas keyhole surgery performed on the thoracic or chest cavity is called thoracoscopic surgery. Laparoscopic and thoracoscopic surgery belong to the broader field of endoscopy. The potentials of these systems enhance the possibilities of the mobile medical care

with those lightweight assistance systems. These assistance systems meet the demands of true solo surgery assistance systems and are robust, versatile, and easy to use. Jankikund Chikitsalaya has inaugurated the 2<sup>nd</sup> Laproscopic machine on 9<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2010 as the Laproscopic surgery has been done for last ten years in Jankikund Chikitsalaya to facilitate the rural community with the latest surgical interventions.
