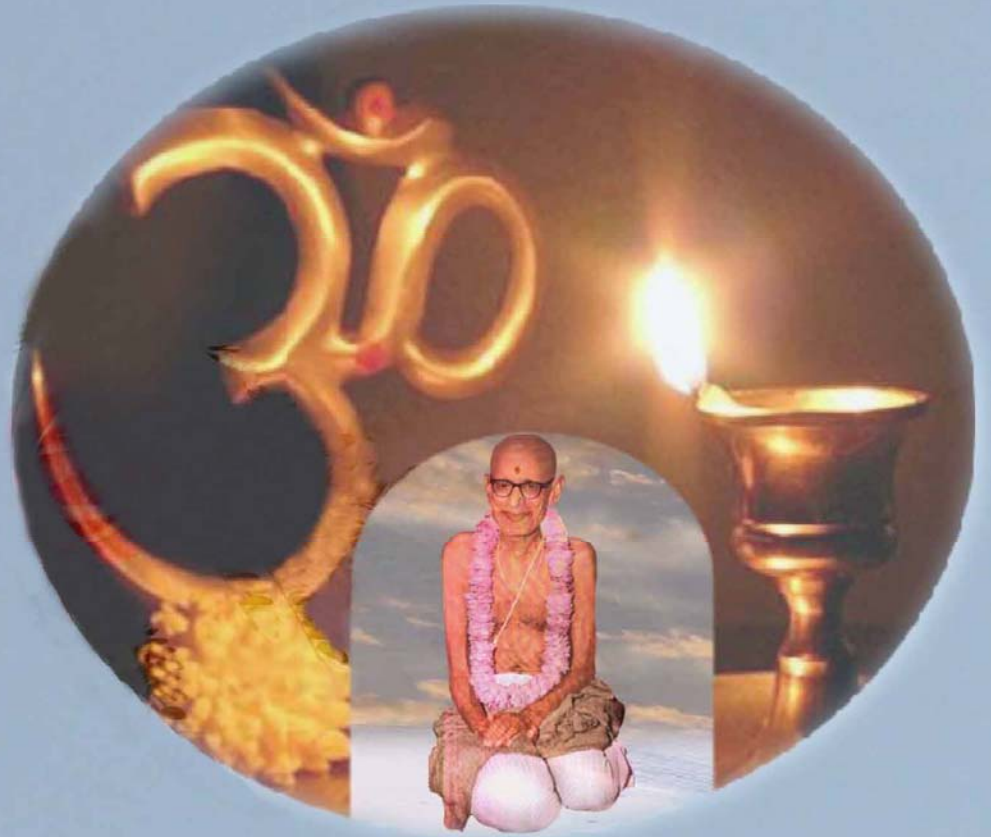

456 million people in India have problems with their vision which need to be corrected. The numbers are large and need to be tackled immediately. To throw focus on visual impairment and blindness, the second Thursday of October is annually designated as World Sight Day. On October 13, 2011, Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya marked this day with free eye screening and awareness program in Mahila Samiti, Sadguru Shiksha Samiti and all 24 Sadguru Vision Centres. Patients with refractive error were provided spectacles and referral done for those in need of surgical intervention.

Piles or haemorrhoids are one of the most common ailments today. It is a varicose and often inflamed condition of the veins, inside or just outside the rectum. In external piles, there is a lot of pain but not much bleeding. In the case of internal piles, there is discharge of dark blood. In some cases the veins burst and this results in what is known as bleeding piles. Jankikund Chikitsalaya organized free piles camp on 13th November, 2011. 78 patients were benefited through ring method done by – Dr. K. Chitania, Rajkot, Gujarat.

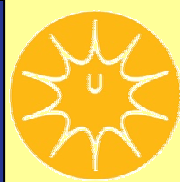
Tulsi Vivah – The Ritual: 06th Nov, 2011

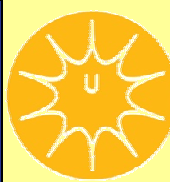
